- Promote understanding and enjoyment of orchestral music through quality "Pops!" concerts focusing on community participation.



HISTORY

The Monterey County Pops! was formed in 1985 by a group of community members and musicians who wanted to expand and enrich the musical experiences available in Monterey County.

Guided by a board numbering between 15 and 20 members, the new symphony began with an annual subscription concert series under the baton first of Oleg Kovalenko and then of Dennis de Coteau. In the late 1980's, the symphony came under the direction of Michael Nowak. At that time, the venues expanded to include Carmel, Monterey, and Salinas.

In 1990, directed by Drs. Jack Bayes and Carl Christensen,



the symphony adopted its current mission: presentation of free public pops and patriotic concerts on holidays.

Since 1990, the fully professional orchestra has presented free outdoor pops

and patriotic concerts annually on the lawn in front of the Old Del Monte Hotel on the campus of the Naval Postgraduate School; provided musical support for the California International Airshow in Salinas; partnered with Monterey County communities to celebrate the 4th of July; and, helped usher in the Holidays with a Children's Concert in Monterey.

In 2012, the Pops! rebranded itself as the Monterey County

Pops! after careful study and consideration. This new name





is designed to bring a crystalclear understanding of the commitment to serve all of

Monterey County with free concerts played by professional musicians emphasizing popular and patriotic music.

MEET OUR MUSICIANS...

Beverly Reese Dorcy, a Minnesota native, is an active

freelance timpanist and percussionist in both the San Diego and San Francisco Bay areas. She has performed with the Marin Symphony, Oakland Symphony, Berkeley Symphony, Symphony, California Francisco Pocket Opera, West Edge Opera, and San Francisco Golden Gate Park Band, among others, and toured Brazil performing with the San



Francisco Women's Philharmonic. She is in her 22nd year with the Monterey County Pops. Beverly has also

performed with the San Diego Symphony, San Diego Opera, California Chamber Orchestra and Orchestra Nova, and was a member of the San Diego Chamber Orchestra for over 15 years. She is a founding member of Millennia Consort and has also played with the Sun Valley Summer Symphony in Idaho.

Prior to moving to California, Ms. Dorcy worked in the Seattle area as principal percussionist with the Bellevue Philharmonic and principal timpanist with the Tacoma Opera. Beverly has recording credits in the film and music industries. She earned her Master of Arts Degree in Percussion Performance from California State University, Fresno, as a student of Steven Schick.

Bruce Dorcy- French horn graduated from the Manhattan



School of Music in New York with a BM in performance. He was Assistant Principal/Third horn of the National Ballet of Canada and Canadian Opera Orchestras from 1968-92 and Principal horn of the Tafelmusik Baroque Orchestra in Toronto for 11 years.

Presently he is Principal horn of the Monterey County Pops! Orchestra and Monterey Opera Orchestra. Bruce has performed with many of the leading arts organizations in North America including: the Toronto Symphony, New York City Opera, New Jersey Symphony, American Ballet Theater, Buffalo Philharmonic, Seattle Symphony, Vancouver Symphony, San Francisco Opera, Las Vegas Philharmonic and San Diego Chamber Orchestra, to name a few. He is also in demand as a studio musician and has performed on over 500 commercial recordings in New York, Toronto, Seattle, San Francisco, and San Diego.
